6.1 Sensory System Principles. Sensory systems for each modality rely on sensory receptor cells, which are specialized to detect particular physical events, called stimuli. Different receptor cells and organs have different thresholds for detecting stimuli. Psychophysicists measure behavioral responses to stimuli to determine the absolute threshold for each modality and the just noticeable difference ( JND) we can detect in stimulus intensity.
