Read the entire question carefully and identify the stem, looking for key phrases or repeated words that can help you identify the correct answer. Tip: An absolute answer is rarely the correct one.

How to Answer NCLEX Questions - Study.com

The same words may appear in the NCLEX question and in the correct answer. It may be the same word or a synonym of the word. This strategy can help you identify correct answer choices. – Odd answers. If one answer stands out as different from the other choices, it may be a signal for the correct answer. – Opposite answers

Types of NCLEX Questions and How They Are Written

The first step to correctly answering NCLEX-RN ® exam questions is to find out what each question is really asking. Step 1 Read each question carefully from the first word to the last word. Do not skim over the words or read them too quickly.

HOW TO PUT THE NCLEX QUESTION AND ANSWER SYSTEM TO USE Take out a practice exam and open to a multiple-choice question. Read the question carefully. Underline any instances where the question hints to the client’s age.

Each standard, multiple-choice NCLEX ® question is divided into two parts: one "stem" and multiple answer options. The stem can range in length from a single sentence to an entire paragraph. The answer options are mostly distractors, except for the one correct choice. Study the sample question below.

The distractors strengthen the question and allow students who know the information to pick the correct answers and to succeed on the test.

However, writing distractors for nursing NCLEX style questions is often just as hard or even harder than writing the stem part of the question. The stem should be able to stand by itself.
