At Levels 5 and 6, the focus is on letter identification and letter-sound relationships. All responses are letters or pictures at Level 5, while Level 6 introduces some word responses.

The Iowa Assessments exam covers the following 10 subject areas: Reading, Written Expression, Mathematics-Concepts and Estimation, Science, Social Studies, Vocabulary, Spelling, Capitalization, Punctuation, and Mathematics-Computation. At grades 3 and below two additional sections, Word Analysis and Listening, are also included in the exam.

ITBS tests are in levels 5-14. Levels 5-8 are for students from kindergarten - second grade (K-2). Sections for levels 5-8 include: Mathematics, Vocabulary, Reading Comprehension, Word Analysis, Listening, Language, Social Studies (Levels 7 and 8 only), Science (Levels 7 & 8 only), and Sources of Information.
