A sharp, denoted by the # symbol, means that note is a semitone (or half step) higher than the note head to its right on sheet music. Conversely, a flat, denoted by a b symbol, means the note is a semitone lower than the note head to its right.

Notes and rests are relative to one another in length, which is why they have fractional names: A whole note is (generally) the longest note used in modern written music. A half note is $\frac{1}{2}$ as long as a whole note. A quarter note is $\frac{1}{4}$ as long as a whole note. An eighth note is $\frac{1}{8}$ as long as a whole note. A sixteenth note is $\frac{1}{16}$
