postpartum hemorrhage occurs in 4 - 6% of pregnancies and it is estimated that a woman dies every 4 minutes worldwide from postpartum hemorrhage, resulting in 140,000 deaths annually. Postpartum hemorrhage also poses other significant risks including coagulopathy, shock, respiratory distress, and can cause long term morbidity.

Late PPH occurs 1 day to 6 weeks after delivery. Risk for bleeding r/t ineffective involution of uterus and hx of postpartum hemorrhage; risk factors: >5 g/p, maternal age >35 yo, pt is not breastfeeding [which aids in uterine contraction], and slight increase in bleeding was seen toward end of shift.

Postpartum hemorrhage (PPH) is hemorrhagic shock, a life threatening, emergency condition. It is defined as blood loss greater than 500 ml or more within 24 hours after birth. PPH occurs in approximately 3% of vaginal births and 6.4% of cesarean births. PPH is a consistent cause of preventable maternal death.

A firm fundus indicates uterine contraction during the postpartum period, which is important to prevent further hemorrhage. Postpartum hemorrhage is designated as blood loss excess of 500 mL within the first 24 hours of delivery.
